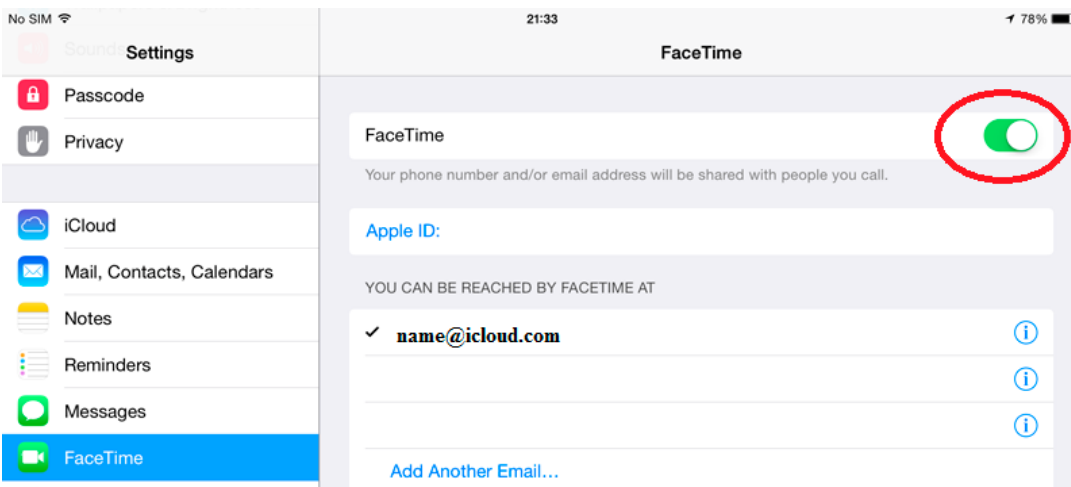
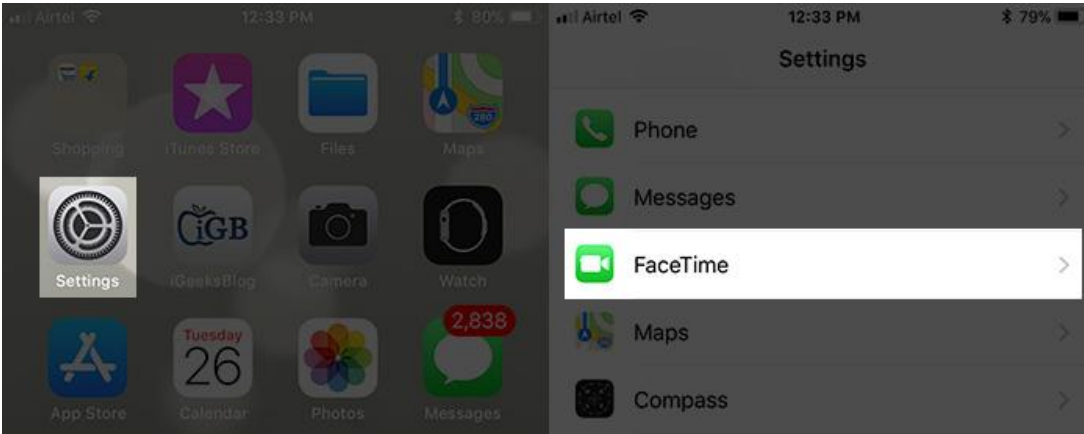



## Using FaceTime on your iPhone or iPad

Tap *Settings* > *FaceTime* and make sure the FaceTime switch is in the On position



## How to Receive a FaceTime Call

With an Internet connection and an Apple ID, you can make and receive calls in the FaceTime

app  (first sign in with your Apple ID, or create an Apple ID, if you don't have one).

Here's how incoming calls work

- **Hearing the call:** When a call comes in, the caller's name will be displayed on the iPhone's or iPad's screen and you will hear the phone ring.
- **Accepting or declining the call:** When a FaceTime call comes in, tap any of the following:
  - If your iPhone or iPad is locked when a FaceTime call comes in, slide the green arrow button to the right to answer. To decline it, do nothing and wait for the caller to give up.



Set up a reminder to return the call later.  
Send the caller a text message.
